Server Configuration:

- Review the SharePoint server environment topology. This includes a list of the service pack/patch levels of SharePoint, the server OS and SQL Server.

SharePoint Status:

- Review the load on each SharePoint Server. The following attributes will be captured:
 - Percentage of physical disk space used vs. available

 - Percentage of memory used vs. available

- Review the backup and disaster recovery (DR) plans that are currently in place.
- Review the current security model used within the SharePoint environment.
- Review any potential workarounds found within the SharePoint environment.
